

# LGBTQ FORUM FOR GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL STUDENTS

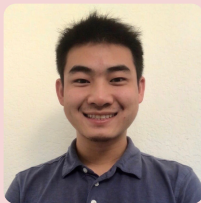


**Thursdays from 4-5 PM**
